Chocolate Wheel: We ask each child to please provide something for the Chocolate Wheel for Pet day.

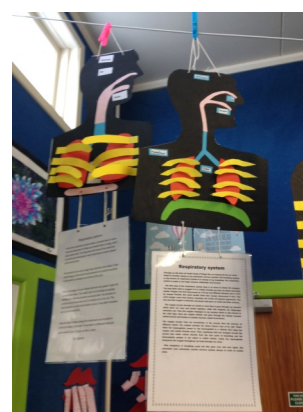
Room 1: A bottle of some sort i.e. soft drink, dessert topping etc.
