INFORMATION EVENING FOR PARENTS OF CHILDREN WHO ARE EXPERIENCING LEARNING DIFFICULTIES

This evening is open to all parents of all aged children, specifically those parents whose children **have not** been formally diagnosed with any type of learning difficulty or those that feel their children are not reaching their potential.

The first half of the evening will provide information about specific learning difficulties and what these can mean for the child, their family, school and teachers. The areas covered will include Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Auditory Processing Disorder, Irlen's Syndrome and Dyspraxia. The second part of the evening will allow for parents to talk with members of the Dyslexia Support Southland team individually, to ask specific questions relevant to their child and for information on the interventions available in Southland. Each of the team members has their own personal story of navigating learning difficulties at a personal or family level. The interventions they bring are a result of that journey.
